

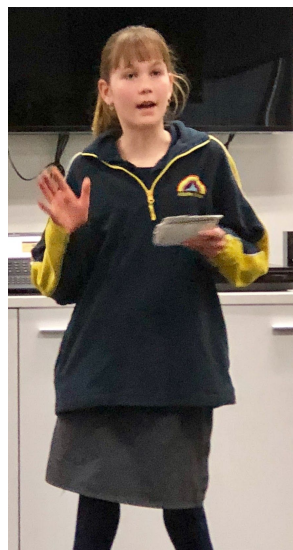
# Waianiwa School Newsletter
